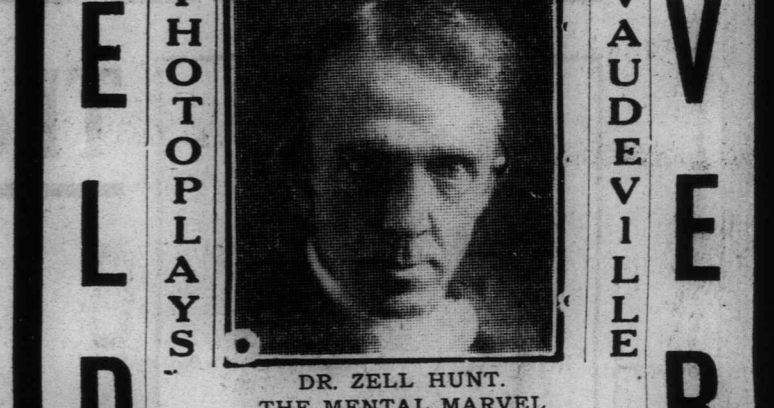

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN HOMESTEAD WEST LAND REGULATIONS. THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a plot of land in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Application must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency), on certain conditions. Dues - Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 30 acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions. Dues - Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity. In certain districts a homesteader's good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$20.00 per acre.
