**Would Restore Ancient Castle**

Buffalo, N. Y., Dec. 14 (A. P.)—Pioneer residents of the Niagara frontier have united in an appeal to the War Department for the preservation of "The Castle," an ancient building at Fort Niagara, erected by the French in 1725.

From a big front room on the first floor of "The Castle" Sir William Johnson is said to have exercised his power over the Indians of the Iroquois country. The second floor is believed to have housed one of the first permanent Catholic chapels in the American wilderness.

Johnson captured the edifice from the French in 1759. It was formally surrendered to the United States by Great Britain in 1796.

The War Department has been asked to restore "The Castle" to its original condition.
