STRATFORD TAXI RATES AMENDED

Police Commission Fixes the Charges To Be Levied For Passengers.

STRAFORD, June 1.—After a somewhat lengthy discussion the police commission has fixed the cab and taxi rates at 25 cents per person within the city limits from 6 a.m. to 11 p.m. From 11 o'clock the rate will be a minimum of \$1 for one or two passengers.
The cabs' tariff was also changed, making the rate 30 cents per hour for a double team, and 60 cents per hour for single horses. The matter of omnibus licenses was left over to get some information about the new provincial law to see how that worked out, and what license was required.
Reeve Sol Koch of Woolwich Township announces that work will be commenced immediately to complete the concrete roadway from Elmira to Kitchener. Workmen will start this week to relay concrete on the section that was built sometime ago, and was damaged owing to bad drainage. Following this work will start simultaneously at Elmira and Waterloo, where there are yet short unpaved stretches. While this work is in progress the highway will be partially closed, and detours will be constructed. By the middle of August, however, it is expected that there will be a clear stretch of pavement for the twelve miles from Elmira to Kitchener.

W. E. Menger of Kitchener was fined \$200 in police court here this week for having liquor in other than his private dwelling place. He said that he had come from Kitchener to his Ford car, and that someone hit him on the head at the corner of Dufferin and Oak streets, and stole the whiskey. When arrested he had one bottle of whiskey in the car. A bat was also found near the car.
