DREYFUS PRESENTS ANOTHER DEFENCE

Writes to Paris Paper Refuting Charge Brought Against Courts

Paris, Oct. 24.—Major Dreyfus has written a letter to the Action Française, a Nationalist organ, in refutation of the accusation which is once again being brought against the courts of Cassation, that it distorted the law when it declared him to be innocent. When it declared him to be innocent by its own authority, instead of sending him for trial by a third court-martial. Various facts have been quoted in support of the charge, advanced, among others by Major Guinet, and advocated by the Action Française, but Major Dreyfus shows conclusively that the law was not distorted. He distorted the law nor exceeded its powers. In one passage of his letter, Major Dreyfus writes:

"The francsais must be aware that the question as to whether the judgment should be quashed with or without another trial was discussed at length and in public, before the Court of Cassation. The most eminent lawyers all take the same view of the 46th clause. They all say, 'The francsais are not to be only required by the law when the innocence of the condemned person is not demonstrated clearly by the discussion of the facts of the case.' When, on the contrary, no portion of the charge can be maintained, there is no reason for such a step, as nothing is to be gained thereby. Moreover, if the law insisted on the non-existence of a crime or offence, in the abstract sense of these terms, there was all the same no reason for another trial. Nothing remained of the charge which could be submitted to discussion by a court, as, on the one hand, it was recognized as innocent of any crime, and, on the other, the francsais were declared to be the author of the offence, but had been acquitted by a judgment of a court-martial, which could not be quashed. The francsais rendered any new trial legally impossible. Besides, the Court of Cassation in rehabilitating me without sending me to a new trial, only adhered to a jurisprudence of more than ten years' date. On Jan. 22, 1888, it proclaimed the innocence of a poor man who had been condemned for desertion by a court-martial when this crime had been committed by another. This decree was read out, explained, and commented on during the discussion at the Court of Cassation. When, 'to sum up, I have been pronounced innocent by the full assembly of the highest magistrates in my country, it remained of the charge which could be discussed, which has reduced to nothing the miserable machinations directed against me.'"

AORANGI ON HER FIFTIETH VOYAGE

Canadian-Australian Liner Has Covered 732,344 Miles—Many Passengers

(From Tuesday's Daily)

The R.M.S. Aorangi, Capt. J. D. S. Phillips, which reached port yesterday with 205 passengers, is making her fiftieth voyage. The steamer will have completed her fiftieth round voyage between Sydney and Vancouver when she arrives at Sydney on December 1st this year. The Aorangi was first placed on the Canadian-Australian Royal Mail service in 1903, running in conjunction with the Warrimoo and Mowera. The latter ships have been replaced by more up-to-date vessels, but the Aorangi will continue in the service. She has carried without mishap many hundreds of passengers from continent to continent, and has covered approximately 732,344 miles. The liner has crossed the Equator 149 times between Australia and Canada. The Aorangi was drifting seaward with a belt tied round his neck.

CUTS RATE ON CHINESE STEERAGE

Waterhouse Line Gives Cheap Fares to the Celestials Home-Bound for New Year

A rate fight to secure the Chinese passenger business from this country to the Orient has been started by Frank Waterhouse, of the Waterhouse Line, by offering special inducements to the Chinese passengers. The regular fare to China from Puget Sound is \$43.50 on all the liners except those of the Waterhouse Line. The Waterhouse Line is offering a special rate of \$35 on the Kumeric, the same as the Canadian vessels.

With the sailing of the Kumeric of the Waterhouse Line last night the special rate of \$35 for steerage passengers went into effect. At this time of year the Chinese passengers are flocking to the Waterhouse Line for the Chinese New Year and other festive days. The outward passage from Suva to the mainland is a large steamer business to the Waterhouse Line.

The special rate of \$35 on the Kumeric includes a rebate of \$5 at the end of the trip, making the rate in reality \$30, and this rebate is given to the passengers at Vancouver, where the vessel leaves for the mainland. The Waterhouse Line is also offering a special rate of \$35 on the Kumeric, the same as the Canadian vessels.

AEON'S CASTAWAYS WELCOMED AT SUVA

Give Interesting Story of Their Experiences When Marooned on Christmas Island

Copies of a special issue of the Western Pacific Herald, of Suva, Fiji Islands, containing an account of the experience of the survivors of the wrecked steamer, the Aeon, at Christmas Island, written by Chaplain Patrick, were received by the steamer Aorangi which arrived from Sydney, Australia, via Suva and is now at anchor in the harbor. All over the country there is a change of 25 to 50 per cent. from the Roosevelt vote of 1904 to Mr. Bryan.
