I have made the most diligent inquiries concerning Mr. Evans, but have received no further information ; but hope I soon shall, in answer to several letters sent to America. Should no certain information be received of, or by, Mr. Evans, I trust that the very strong probability of the existence of such a people, as evinced by the preceding papers, will induce the Missionary Society, or some other body of Christians in England, or America, to send a sufficient number of persons, properly informed and provided, fully to investigate a matter so replete with curiosity and importance.
