**Scientific and Useful.**

**GRAHAM CAKE.**—A very good cake is made of two cups of Graham flour, one cup of sugar, one cupful of sour cream, two eggs, beaten very light, and one teaspoonful of soda. Bake an hour.

**COFFEE CAKE WITHOUT EGGS.**—One cup of old, strong coffee, one cup each of molasses and sugar, one-half cup butter, four cups of flour, one cup of raisins and one teaspoonful of soda; flavour with cloves, cinnamon, allspice and nutmeg.

**A RAT ENTERMINATOR.**—A writer in *Chamber's Journal* says that chloride of lime mixed with water will effectually drive rats from their haunts, and claims to have rid an infested ship and his own house of these pests. The plan is a very cheap one and easily applied, and at all events is effective as a deodorizer and disinfectant.

**WELL TO REMEMBER.**—A stitch in time saves nine. Serious results oft follow a neglect of constipation, indigestion and bad blood. Burdock Blood Bitters regulate and purify the stomach, bowels, liver, kidneys and the blood. Take it in time.

**ORANGE OMELETTE.**—Two eggs, yolks and whites beaten separately, two table spoonfuls orange juice, two teaspoonfuls powdered sugar, pinch of salt; add all this to beaten yolks; put in the beaten whites, place in well-buttered omelette pan, cook carefully until browned on bottom, then place in oven on grate till cooked through.

**WAFFLES WITH SOUR CREAM.**—One pint of sour cream, two eggs, one pint of flour, one table spoonful of corn meal, one teaspoonful of soda, one-half teaspoonful of salt. Beat the eggs separately, mix the cream with the beaten yolks, stir in the flour, corn meal and salt, add the soda dissolved in a little sweet milk, and last the whites beaten to a stiff froth.

**BRONCHITIS.** Unless arrested, will terminate in consumption. An almost never failing cure for this complaint is found in Allen's Lung Balsam, which can be had of any druggist, price one dollar per bottle.

**MINCED VEAL.**—Cut the meat from the bones and mince fine with a piece of lemon peel and a sprig of parsley, salt and pepper; put the bones into a saucepan with a chopped onion and a sprig of savoury; stew them to make gravy. When done strain it off, and thicken with a little flour and butter, let it boil up, and then add the mince; stir all well together, and when hot remove from the stove and pour over slices of toast.

**POTATO SOUP.**—Cook a slice of salt pork in three pints of water, and boil hard till all possibility of fat is cooked out. The water should be reduced to a quart; then add an onion chopped fine and eight large potatoes, first boiled and mashed. Cook slowly for half an hour, then add enough scalding milk to thin it to the consistency of pea soup. Add salt and white pepper for flavouring; strain through a coarse sieve or colander and pour into a hot tureen, in which should first be put a table spoonful of melted butter.

**TEA CAKE.**—A very good tea cake is made by beating to a cream half a cup of butter and two cups of sugar, with one cup of milk and a teaspoonful of soda dissolved in it. Beat well together, then add one cup of flour with two teaspoonfuls of cream of tartar rubbed in it and the well-beaten yolks of three eggs. Beat the whites separately until stiff; add them and two more cups of flour to the ingredients; beat well, butter two tins, pour in the cake and bake for twenty minutes or half an hour. Carefulness in baking is important.

**ICE CREAM CAKE.** One cup of sugar, one-half cup of butter, one half cup of sweet milk, two cups of flour, one-and-a-half teaspoonfuls of baking powder, whites of three eggs well beaten, one teaspoonful of vanilla; make three layers and bake in a hot oven. Frosting—Yolks of three eggs, one cup of sugar, one-half teaspoonful of vanilla; beat fifteen minutes, when it will be like cream. Put this on each layer and on top of the cake, then set in a hot oven for a few minutes till the frosting is a little set, then take out and when the cake is cold the frosting will be firm.
