

ARTICLE II

Co-operation under this Agreement shall encompass such scientific and applied fields of space exploration as solar-terrestrial physics, remote sensing of the Earth, material sciences and biotechnology, space biology and medicine, space geodesy, space astronomy and may also embrace other fields which may from time to time be decided upon by mutual agreement between the Parties.

ARTICLE III

Co-operation under Article 2 of this Agreement may include some or all of the following activities:

- a) arranging exchanges of scientists, specialists, students and trainees;
- b) facilitating the development of and participation in joint research and projects, as determined by scientific and other research organizations;
- c) exchanging the results of experiments, scientific information and literature;
- d) co-operating in joint projects for the design, construction and launch of apparatus;
- e) holding joint symposia and conferences; and
- f) other joint activities mutually agreed by the Parties.

ARTICLE IV

Each Party shall nominate the appropriate organization(s) which shall be responsible for the implementation of the co-operative activities and experiments developed in accordance with this Agreement.

ARTICLE V

Scientific and technical information obtained through the conduct of joint experiments carried out under this Agreement shall be accessible to both Parties and be transmitted as soon as practicable.
