

University-to-university agreement, both for students and faculty. In 1994, six students from Marburg studied at the University of Alberta and six students from the University of Alberta studied at Marburg.

Marburg students are selected by a committee of representatives of the "Akademisches Auslandsamt", Marburg scholars and a native speaker of English at Marburg University. Canadian students are selected by a similar committee including representatives of the International Office of the University of Alberta.

Students remain enrolled at their home university and pay their home fees only. Up to three of the German students who take part in the exchange are students of Geography who are paid by the DAAD under its IAS program. IAS students receive up to DM 700 per month and a sum of DM 2000 to cover travel expenses. German students who are entitled to Bafög may receive up to the full Auslands-Bafög.
