

Mr. Sinclair moved,—That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at the next sitting of the House to consider the following proposed Resolution:—

That it is expedient to introduce a measure providing for the approval and confirmation of the International Convention for the High Seas Fisheries of the North Pacific Ocean, signed by Canada, the United States and Japan, in Tokyo, on the 9th of May, 1952, and for carrying out Canada's obligations under the Convention.

Whereupon, Mr. Sinclair, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, informed the House, That His Excellency the Governor General, having been informed of the subject-matter of the said proposed Resolution, recommends it to the House.

That it is expedient to present a measure to amend The Judges Act, 1946, to authorize payment of a salary for an additional judge of the Supreme Court of British Columbia.

Whereupon, Mr. Garson, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, informed the House, That His Excellency the Governor General, having been informed of the subject-matter of the said proposed Resolution, recommends it to the House.

Resolved, That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at the next sitting of the House to consider the said proposed Resolution.

Mr. Winters moved,—That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at the next sitting of the House to consider the following proposed Resolution:—

That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend The National Housing Act, 1944, to increase the appropriation provided by section 7 for loans under Part I from \$300,000,000. to \$500,000,000., and the appropriation provided by section 13 for loans under Part II from \$150,000,000. to \$250,000,000., also with respect to grants in aid of slum clearance and to certain other matters deemed necessary for the proper administration of the Act.
