NOTICES OF MOTION.

For Wednesday, 27th November, 1867.

By the Honorable Mr. *Wilmot* :

Nov. 25.—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency will cause to be laid before this House, copies of all documents, agreements and correspondence respectively, between the Executive Government of the late Province of Canada, or of this Dominion, with the President, Directors or Managers of the Bank of *Montreal*, relative to the issue of Provincial Notes, under the Act passed on the 15th of August, 1866, with copies of any minutes or memoranda of Council relative thereto, with a detailed and separate account of any and all charges for issuing the same, and also a statement of all charges made by the said Bank for moneys advanced for the Public Service, since the 30th day of June, 1866, specifying the Rates of Interest and other charges made by the said Bank.
