PROVISIONS AS TO NOTICES

106. The Clerk shall also announce, by notices affixed in the committee rooms and lobbies of the Senate, by the first day of every session, the times limited for receiving Petitions for Private Bills, and Private Bills, and reports thereon. 107. All applications to parliament for Publication Private Bills of any nature whatsoever, shall be advertised by notice published in the Canada Gazette. Such notice shall clearly and distinctly state the nature and objects of the application, and shall be signed by or on behalf of the applicants, with the address of the party signing the same; and, when the application is for an Act of Incorporation, the name of the proposed company shall be

stated in the notice.
