Dear Sir Arthur :

I am writing to you because I know no
one else ^{with} ~~to~~ whom I could communicate. We are anxious to form an Inter-
University English Billiard Tournament to be held annually and composed of
McGill, Queens and Toronto.

I should be very grateful if McGill would
give me their support in this. The teams would consist of four or six men
selected on any basis which each individual University might think it
advisable.

Would it be possible for McGill to send
here a "plenipotentiary" as soon as possible who would have authority to
agree to a constitution covering the proposed tournament? I should see
that your representative would be the guest of the University during his
stay here.

I think it would be a very good thing if
such a tournament could be organized as it would bring together another
group of University students not represented by Rugby or Hockey.
