- The following despatch from Halifax, N.S., October 5th, gives somewhat in detail the results of recent prospecting in the Queen's County gold district, a field of discovery that is now attracting much interest:

"During the past week quite a number of persons have been prospecting at the Middletield gold district. Queen's Co., with satisfactory results. a distance of three feet. Two of the leads run together, making one wide lead. Whether the gold is contained in the leads in paying quantities is yet to be demonstrated. Near Mill village, also in Queen's Co., it is said a vein of quartz has been discovered eighteen inches in width, containing valuable specimens of silver qre."
