by the Lay Secretary to each Member. Seven Members of the Council, of whom four must be Laymen, shall, in all all cases, form a quorum for the transaction of business.

BRANCH SOCIETIES.

Branch Societies may be established at any places in the Province by arrangement with the Council, which body shall have power to issue the necessary authority for the formation and guidance of all such Branches. All funds collected by Branches shall be remitted to the Treasurer of the Society, after payment of the necessary local expenses.

CHANGES IN CONSTITUTION.

Alterations in the Constitution may be made at any Meeting of the Society by the vote of at least two-thirds of the Members present, provided that one month's previous notice in writing of the proposed changes has been fyled with the President and Secretaries, or any two of them, who shall give immediate notice to all Members of the Council.
