Thee, O Father, that (as David did admit Mephibosheth to his table for his father's sake: so) Thou wouldest suffer me to be partaker of Thy heavenly table, for Thy Son's sake, Who with so great labour and sorrow did regenerate us, by His Death on the Cross, and liveth and reigneth with Thee and the Holy Spirit, for ever and ever. Amen.

Then say the following Hymn for the Holy Sacrament:

SPEAK O tongue, the Body broken,
Giv'n to be the spirit's food;
And the Word Almighty spoken
Which hath turned the wine to blood,
Of the King the awful token,
And celestial brotherhood.

Born for us, and for us given,
Of a virgin undefil'd,
Scattering wide the seeds of Heav'n,
Sojourned He in this world's wild;
And on that remember'd even,
His appointed course fulfill'd.
