Christ and Calvary is the answer. Christ was not the victim of the wrath of God. He was God reconciling man to Himself in that wondrous life and death of love. Father Damien, who went among the loathsome lepers and gave his life a victim to that awful malady, had a right to claim for himself the sacred name of "friend of the lepers." How much more has the Maker and Sustainer of the universe, who became man and died the death of the cross, the right to claim that thrice-blessed name. We are saved, not by the cross or the sufferings
