Toronto Still Undefeated

TORONTO HANDS CURRIE A LEMON MAPLE LEAFS TRIM BISON 8-5

Score Seven Runs Off Farmer Toronto Twirler in First Innings—We Still Lead—Montreal, Newark and Jersey City Win.

Kelly's Maple Leafs kept up their winning stride yesterday, defeating the Bisons on their own stamping grounds by a score of 8-5, tallying seven runs in the first inning. Currie, who managed to draw pay from Toronto for nearly two years, was knocked out of the box. Montreal shut out Rochester, while the Skeeters and St. Louis won.
