CHICAGO GOSSIP.

Henry A. King & Co., 12 King-street cast, received the following despatch to-day from Chicago:

The general liquidation of long contracts during last week has not surprised the shrewder portion of the speculative element. The break in prices has stimulated the export demand. Foreigners have been waiting for it and their hopes have been realized. The break has been helped largely by the absence of outside trade, which it is to be hoped will come into the market under favorable conditions now existing. We have had a 12c break. It has cleared the speculative a atmosphere and every known law of chance would suggest a sharp reaction, particularly when the market has been depressed below its natural level. There is very little evidence that English wheat millers have made any preparation to replenish the depleted stocks. Their purchases during the past month have been from hand to mouth. European supplies have been very low and crop prespects have not been above the average. We do not take any stock in the crop damage reports, which have been coming in and are inclined to think, from all we can learn, that the growing crop is in the best possible condition. Harvest is already in progress in Buenos Ayres, and there will be about 40,000,000 bushels to export from that country. Ocean freights are very low and they are a great factor in the distribution of food supplies. World's shipments were 5,180,000 bushels. Eleven loads wheat reported taken for export to-day.

Corn and Oats was moderately active under a fair trade. Opening prices were weak, in sympathy with wheat, but quickly firmed up on good buying. The range covered %c to ½c. Visible supply of corn increased 220,000 bushels and oats increased 19,000 bushels. The markets closed steady. Receipts of corn 484 cars and oats 252 cars.
