Mulock Liberal Club. Dr. Greig presided at a large meet-ing of the Mulock Liberal Club last evening in the O'Neill Building, Par-liament-street. The speaker of the evening was John Wells of Port Arthur, who described the wonderful resources of New Ontario. He advocated the opening up of roads thruout the coun-try, and stated that at the present time it was impossible to drive out-side Port Arthur farther than 18 miles owing to the want of roads. He thought that Port Arthur and Fort William would in the near future, providing the government deepened the canals to allow occan going steamers to pass thru, make a bid for the trade of northern and western On-tario, which was now going to To-ronto. A vote of thanks was tendered the speaker at the conclusion of his address. Thomas Blezard, M.L.A., of East Peterboro, was present, and ad-dressed the gathering, on the polloy of the government.
