Besides, if Admiral *de Fantes's* Letter be genuine, of his Meeting in his Boat a *Boston* Vessel trading beyond the West of *Hudson's Bay*, after leaving his Ship in *Lake Belle*, upon sailing from *Lima* round *California*, to 54° North Latitude, wherein he names the Master's Name and Pilot's, *Shapley* and *Seymour Gibbons*, and we find a Family of the Name of *Shapley* then lived at *Boston*; there would be no further Need of Proof to demonstrate there being a navigable Passage from *Hudson's-Bay* to the Western Ocean of *America*.
