



market. The demand for the special-ties was practically nil and many of the bids were nominal. With a few exceptions there is no desire on the part of insiders to take stock even at the prevailing prices. Speculative holders are sufficiently optimistic to hang on, hoping for a revival of some kind, and it is an exceptional case where any of these can now see a profit. The loose war bonds are grad-ually being assimilated, and with these again at or around the issued prices the way will be open for an-other Canadian issue. The prospect of this does not help the speculative position, and is rather the reverse.


