

PHARMACY. Advanced work in one or more of the following :—

- (a) Assay of the organic drugs official in the British Pharmacopæia.
- (b) Methods of preparation of the official galenical compounds, and detection of impurities and adulterations.
- (c) Dispensing methods, including the subject of incompatibility.

CHEMISTRY. Advanced work in one or more of the following :—

- (a) Volumetric Analysis as applied to official chemicals.
- (b) Analysis of Potable and Mineral waters and Urinary Analysis.
- (c) Plant Analysis.

MATERIA MEDICA. Advanced work in one or more of the following :—

- (a) Principles of Pharmacognosy. (Flückiger's Manual must be carefully studied.)
- (b) Therapeutics of official drugs.

BOTANY. Advanced work in one or more of the following :—

- (a) Classification.
- (b) Bacteriology.
