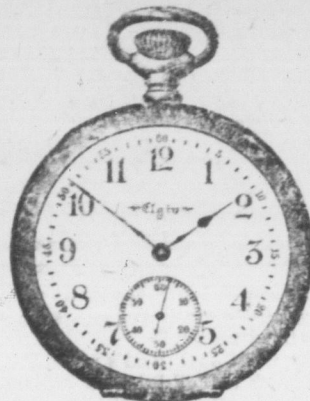

DOMINION ENDEAVORS TO OBTAIN CUSTODY OF \$22,000,000 C.P.R. STOCK HELD BY GERMAN.  
MONTREAL.—By an action entered in the Real courts the Dominion of Canada seeks to have the minister-general of Finance or the receiver-general of Canada appointed custodian for C.P.R. stock valued at \$22,000,000 (twenty two million dollars), the property of enemy shareholders.

The action is taken by the secretary of state of the Dominion under the order respecting trade with the enemy which was passed in 1916.

Common stock to the number of 143,575 shares and valued at the present time at \$22,000,000 is affected. Most of the stock is held by German banks. F. A. Meredith, acting on behalf of the C.P.R. opposed the petition, which came before Justice Dugas this afternoon on the ground that the transfer offices of the railway company in London and Paris should have been notified. Judge Dugas over-ruled the objection on the ground that such notifications would be of no effect.

Mr. Meredith then asked for delay on the ground that he was not ready to proceed and asked that the case be adjourned for a week. Jean Lafleur, K. C., acting for the secretary of state, opposed delay on the ground that peace would be signed between now and April 12, in which case the government would lose its resources.

The judge agreed to the adjournment for a week, but reserved to the government the right to proceed immediately should an emergency arise.

### APPEAL FOR COTTIN IS REFUSED

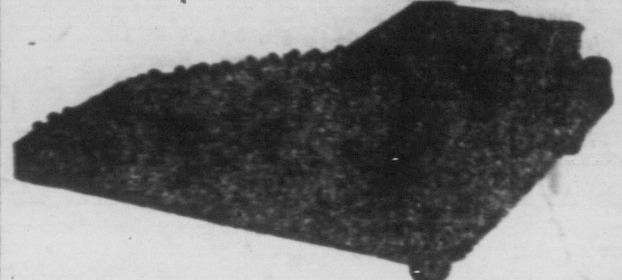
