Resolved, That the number of Minutes printed and circulated, be according to the monies received from the Churches; and that Minutes be sent to Churches, according to the amounts sent by them.

And further Resolved, That Revs. I. E. Bill and W. S. McKenzie be a Committee to superintend the printing and circulating the same.
