

ECLIPSES, 1879.—In the year 1879, there will be three eclipses; two of the sun and one of the moon.
 I. An annular eclipse of the sun, Jan. 28. Invisible to North America. Visible to portions of South America and Africa.
 II. An annular eclipse of the sun, July 19. Invisible to North America. Visible to Africa and to small portions of Europe and Asia.
 III. A partial eclipse of the moon, Dec. 28. Visible more or less to the world generally, except in South America and the larger portion of North America. To places in California, the moon will set in the morning slightly staged with the advancing penumbral shade.
