

MOTT, WILLIAM ALBERT (*Restigouche*).

S. of the late Wm. Mott, Magistrate and Court Commr. B. at Campbellton, N.B., 29 Nov. 1864. Ed. at Dalhousie Grammar School. M., 25 Sept., 1894, Harriet E., dau. of John Henderson. Called to the Bar N.B., 1888, and is in partnership with John McAlister, M.P. Is Swedish and Norwegian Consul, and was Mayor of Campbellton in 1892. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g.e., 1892, and re-elected at g.e., 1895. A Conservative.—*Campbellton, N.B.*

O'BRIEN, JAMES (*Charlotte*).

B. at Windsor, N.S., in 1834. M. Miss Nutter of St. George. Has been a blacksmith for several years, and was Scott Act Inspector for Co. of Charlotte. First returned to Ho. of Assem. in 1892, and re-elected 1895. A Liberal.—*St. George, N.B.*

O'BRIEN, JOHN (*Northumberland*).

Parents were natives of Irel. B. at Nelson, N.B., 20 Feb., 1847, and ed. there. M., 15 Oct., 1890, Lillie, dau. of the late P. M. C. Peake, Postmaster of Fredericton. Is a merchant and a lumberer. Has been a County Councillor and Warden of the County. Is Vice-Presdt. of the Agric. Soc. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g.e., 1890, and re-elected at g.e., 1892 and 1895. A Liberal-Conservative.—*Nelson, N.B.*

OSMAN, CHARLES J. (*Albert*).

Is secretary of the A. M. Co. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at by-election held 23 Jan., 1897, to fill vacancy caused by resignation of Dr. Lewis, who was elected to the Commons at g.e., 1896. A Liberal.—*Hillsboro, N.B.*

PAULIN, PROSPER ELIZE (*Gloucester*).

B. in Caraquet, Oct., 1844, and ed. at the Parish Schools. M., 23 Nov., 1869, Vitaline Gauvin, of Caraquet. Is a teacher, an auctioneer and a J. P. Has been a parish Court Commr., Municipal Councillor for eight years, and Warden of the County for two terms. Holds a commission as Ensign in the Reserve Militia. First returned to the Ho. of Assem. at g.e., 1895. A Conservative.—*Caraquet, N.B.*
