These are our real sentiments and the truth, which we wish to make known to our Father, and at the same time we would entreat His Excellency once more to glance over our Petition, and according to His Promise to render us justice, and to relieve our distresses. —

We tell you in conclusion that we have no choice to make; we must one all become Tillers of the Ground, otherwise we must Starve. —

The Isle aux allumettes is the place we have selected for the settlement of our Families, we have already mentioned this in our Petition to our Father of the 9<sup>th</sup> March 1840, and we earnestly hope He will approve of ours
