I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 27th ultimo, in regard to purchase of land from Mr. Sproull for the Fisher's Grant Indians, and inclosing a description of the land for insertion in the deed. In reply I beg to inclose a corrected description, which is considered satisfactory.

As regards carrying out the exchange, I may say that it is necessary to obtain a surrender of the portion of land on the Indian Reserve to be conveyed to Mr. Sproull and the local Indian agent has been given the necessary instructions in this matter.

I would beg to call attention to the fact that the conveyance should be to His Majesty the King as represented by the Honourable the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs.
