Johnson (SASO) Wing Commander Chalf (CMO), Squadron Leader Snetsinger and Flight Lieutenant Ashlin, from No. 1 Training Command, visited the Station.</p> <p>Harvard 2623 piloted by Aus. 411785, LAC, Hogan, W.J. and Yale 3373 piloted by Aus 40563 LAC Loginoff, N.A., were involved in a mid air collision at 1500 hrs., 2 miles south of main aerodrome, during formation flying. LAC Hogan was killed and LAC Loginoff died from result of injuries sustained in collision. Cause of crash is obscure pending Court of Inquiry. Categorized - Harvard 2623 A, Yale 3373 A.</p>
