In reply to your letter of the 25th Instant, regarding your application to purchase the portion of Lake No.2, in the Township of Dawson, situate on Lot No.30, Con.8, I beg to say that the Department is not prepared to say that if the Lake is offered for sale, you will be given the first chance of purchasing this portion.

I may say that it may be considered advisable to make disposition of the whole Lake in order that the best possible price may be realized therefor in the interests of the Indians.
