Ottawa, 14th February, 1918.

Sir.

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 1st ultimo, with respect to Chief John Ashnola, the particular of which have been noted.

In reply I beg to say that the Department concurs in the action you took in this matter but it does not appear that there is anything further you could do. If the Chief desires to recover the stock disposed of by his son it seems to the Department that he should promptly consult a lawyer on his own behalf and take such action as may be advised.
