THE POLISH GOVERNMENT IS BACKED BY THE POLISH PROPLE.

Labour Paper WRN (initials for Freedom, Equality, Independence - in the Polish language). It was reproduced as a supplement to POLAND FIGHTS, a New York bulletin, on Jan. 20th, 1944:

"The Polish Government in London is representative of the broad social forces of Poland. It is based on the confidence of Polish workers, peasants, and democratic intellectuals. Difficulties resulting from the conspiratorial technique of political activities in Poland make it hard to include minor Polish political groups inside Poland that accept the Polish Government's statement of democratic principles and the coalition agreement. But their co-operation is wholehearteely accepted and welcome. Thus, the Polish Government expresses the coordinated desires and wishes of the democratically-minded masses of the Polish People, which constitute, undoubtedly the majority of the nation".

2. From a statement of the Polish Labour Group in New York, issued on Jan. 17th, 1944:

"The Polish Government is a coalition government in which all major political parties are represented. Representatives of the workers and peasants (over 80% of the Polish population) hold a majority in that government, which is in close and regular contact with Poland and which speaks for the People of our Country:

3. From the Left Wing Socialist Weekly TRIBUNE (London), the latest number:

"The Polish Government in London is a coalition of Great Polish Political Parties. The fact that the governmental coalition which includes the peasant party and the socialist represents the Polish people cannot be seriously questioned. Nor can its close contact with the Polish Underground Movements be doubted".... "Every informed student of Polish affairs knows that the Union of Polish Patriots in Moscow is a completely unrepresentative body".
