 Pte Fagerik was removed to the Reg. Aid Post and given necessary treatment before being evacuated by the Fd. Ambulance.

1st Ques by Prosecutor: Capt Maley can you indicate on your own leg the point of the wounds?

Ans: Capt. Maley indicated points on either side of his left leg about an inch apart with outside one being higher.

2nd Ques by Pros: Was the patient conscious?

Ans: Yes.

3rd Ques by Pros: Did Pte Fagerik make any statement at the time?

Ans: In answer to a question Pte Fagerik said that his rifle had gone off while he was cleaning it, or words to that effect.

1st Ques by Defence: In your opinion what would the position of the rifle have to be to inflict such a wound?

Ans: It would have to be at an angle of about forty five degrees to the body with the butt uppermost.

The Prosecutor received permission and indicated a lying position with knee bent and rifle with butt on floor and muzzle against thigh. He asked
