which will represent the tens or 30; then a pause of five seconds, when four blows will be given representing the units, or four, thus: 111-1111-34.

Single numbers up to nine, are struck consecutively or continuously, out any break, until the whole number is given. The number of the box pulled will be repeated four or five times with an interval between.
