### HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY. FREDERICTON, TUESDAY, 5th July, 1808.

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY having been Prorogued to this Day, then to meet for the dispatch of Business. The House met accordingly.

A MESSAGE was delivered from His HONOR the PRESIDENT requiring the attendance of this House in the Council Chamber. The House attended accordingly and being returned, Read a first time, "A Bill for the bet-"ter encouragement of Agriculture and Fishery." The Speaker then reported that the House had attended His HONOR the PRESIDENT in the Council Chamber, when His HONOR was pleased to make the following SPEECH to both Houses, and that to prevent mistakes he had procured a copy of the same, which he read in his place, and is as follows, to wit:

" Gentlemen of the Council, " and Gentlemen of the Assembly,

"His MAJESTY having thought fit to direct the most active measures to "be taken for strengthening the defences of the British possessions in North "America, and having been graciously pleased at the same time to express "his reliance upon the Legislatures of the respective Provinces for making "every exertion consistent with their internal resources, with a view to the "General Defence; it became my duty on being appointed to the Admi-"nistration of this Government, to give you without delay an opportunity "in General Assembly, to fulfil His MAJESTY's just expectations, on this "momentous occasion, by such legal Provisions, as our situation may re-"quire, and by making such amendments as may be necessary in the pre-"sent Law for regulating the Militia of this Province.

"These are the principal objects that I have at present to recommend "to your consideration, such further particulars as I may have to suggest "shall be communicated by Message.

" I have ordered the Treasurer's Accounts, and such other documents as the may be able to furnish for your information to be laid before you, of such expences as it may now be necessary to provide for, in addition to the
