JAPANESE AFFAIRS.

(Courier Leased Wire).
TOKIO, Feb. 5.—The upper house of Diet opened today, Prince Katsura, Premier and Minister of Foreign Affairs, addressing the chamber said the relations between Japan and the foreign powers continue friendly and that everything is contributing towards the preservation of peace in the Far East.

The speech in the main was devoted to finance. Prince Katsura said the government proposed to effect administrative and financial reforms which would save at least 50,000,000 yen (\$25,000,000) annually. The government had decided upon a policy of retrenchment and the lightening of the burden of the people as far as was consistent with the maintenance of the national strength.

The premier added that the government proposed to reduce government loans and limit treasury bill outstanding to 500,000,000 yen and also steadily to reduce the national debt.
