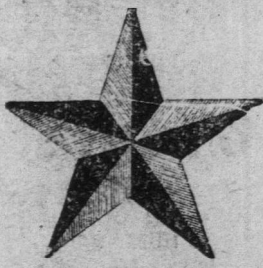
### Lectures!

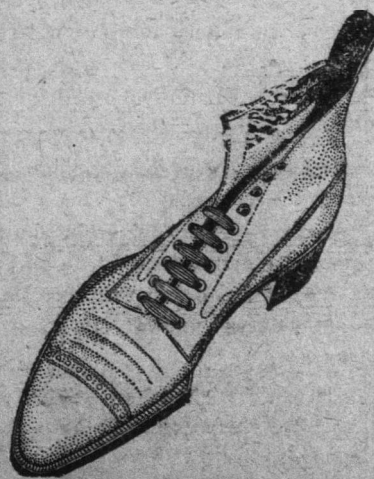
