REPORT OF CHIEF AGENT S.P.A.  
ONE WEEK ENDING JAN. 19.

Called to the West End to hu-  
manely destroy a horse that had cut  
its leg which festered. It had been  
attended to for three  
days and the owner decided to have  
it destroyed; also destroyed another  
at East End, the animal was old  
and had been working and the owner  
did not want to have it humanely de-  
stroyed. The two horses referred to  
last week's report have been well  
cared for by the Veterinary Sur-  
geon and attended to by Vet. Mc-  
Nair. The owner of the little dog  
had been run over on Water  
Street and sent for me. I advised him  
to let Vet. McNair; the dog is now  
recovering. In cases like these, ac-  
cording to law teamsters or motormen  
run over any animal must stop  
and have it properly attended to.  
This was not done in this case.  
I destroyed two dogs which were suf-  
fering from cancer. Attended to  
a number of other calls. Found  
who overdrive lame horses must  
be brought to court. All teamsters  
on Water Street are requested  
to have their horses' walk when hand-  
led. I may also state that  
the "Horse Prayer" has been  
passed in the House of As-  
sembly and will be published in the  
Telegraph. Quite a number of the S.P.A.  
members have purchased this week and quite a  
few remain. The Society will be  
supplying any horses of animals  
the same we would like to see one  
every window and in all public  
places. The price is only 12  
cents framed. All complaints
