**HYDRO FOR AYLMEER**

By-Law Carries by Big Majority of 292. Only 43 Vote Against It.

With no uncertain sound the rate-payers of Aylmer declared in favor of Hydro power on Monday last. The vote was a fairly large one, 292 being recorded, 233 of whom were in favor, and 43 against it. All we think, believed in Hydro power, but a few were fearful that the change would mean increased taxes, and decided that a later date for installing it would be preferable.

The promoters of the scheme were well organized, and autos were busy from 9 a.m. until the polls closed at 5 p.m. bringing in the voters. Otherwise the vote would have been much smaller, as many accepted the conclusion that it was sure to carry, and did not intend to take the time to vote. The smallness of the vote against the measure was a surprise to even its most enthusiastic advocates, and is an evidence that the people have entire confidence in Sir Adam Beck and the Hydro Commission.

We understand that the materials for installing are to hand, and work will be started as soon as they can be placed on the ground. It is expected that everything will be completed within two or three months after work is started. Now that the by-law has been passed, the sooner the better, as the town now has a good opportunity to dispose of the present engines, boilers, etc., we are told, at a price little less than their original cost. If this be correct, it is an evidence that our plant is not "junk" as designated by some parties not very well informed.

The vote giving the council authority for the issuing of debentures to meet the expense of installation, was practically the same as the by-law for installing.

Now that this most important question is settled, let all differences of opinion be forgotten, and all work together to make it an unqualified success. The great big majority wanted Hydro, and the majority rules.


