\$2,500 TO MEND A BROKEN HEART
Breach of Promise Case Lasted Ten Minutes, and Plaintiff Wins.

LICENSES FOR THE SOCIAL CLUBS
Inspector Galpin Says W. C. T. U. Should Petition the City Council.

SERIOUS CHARGES MADE
Mr. Galpin Alleges That Much Drinking and Gambling is Going On in Such Places in London.

At a largely-attended meeting of the W. C. T. U. yesterday afternoon, Inspector Galpin urged the members in the most forcible manner to petition the city council to make it compulsory for each of the social clubs of the city to take out a license.

Inspector Galpin stated that clubs, particularly those whose members included young men and boys, were now very numerous in the city. Some of these organizations had secured rooms above stores.

In other cases the youths meet in private homes. There, he stated, a good deal of drinking and gambling being carried on in clubs of this nature, and the influence were in many cases very bad, particularly on the younger boys.

Inspector Galpin thought the W. C. T. U. could do splendid work by petitioning the council to compel these boys' clubs to take out licenses, as by this means a regular inspection would be provided for, and a great deal that is undesirable now could be eliminated.
