I have now practically finished my task. They are all sorted and pretty thoroughly indexed, ten generations of writers ages. "They are all of outstanding interest," he answered with enthusiasm, "although different manuscripts will appeal to different people. For example, there are two letters from Edmund Burke in his own handwritting. They are both written to the Vatican, and in one he urges with energy and almost with violence the advantages of an alliance between this country and the Holy See. Then there is a letter from Nelson thanking the Pope for having given him permission to revietual his ships at an Italian port, and others from Hood. One particularly interesting manuscrapt gives a graphic description of the battle of Toulon. "In addition, there is a whole series of letters from Cardinal Erskine, who was ambassador in England during the reign of George III. He kept the Vatican very well informed of all his deeds and movements and some of his comments on contemporary figures and contemporary society are exceedingly interesting. It would not be too much to say that no one who wants to study that period in English history could afford to neglect that series of letters, several hundred in number, which have hitherto been hidden away in the library at the Vatican.
