Steamer Amur—as was told in the Colonist yesterday morning—brought down the first Klondikers to come out from Dawson this spring. The Gutch followed close behind her, bringing more to Vancouver, and the steamer City of Seattle was expected to reach that port early this morning with a crowd. To the C. P. N. Co.'s steamer Amur belongs the credit of bringing the first arrivals from Dawson. There were thirty in all on the Amur. In all over 200 had arrived up the river and the trains were daily bringing them and their gold into Skagway.
