THE COURT OF APPEAL AND THE BOARD OF WORKS INVESTIGATION.

On Saturday afternoon judgments was given at Ogoude Hall in this appeal of the City of Toronto and Judge Macdonnell against the conduct of Judge Robertson in the Court of Chancery a year ago, granting a writ of prohibition which puts a stop to the Board of Works investigation and restrained Judge Macdonnell from continuing the inquiry into certain allegations made against Contractor A. W. Godwin.

Chief Justice Hargry reviewed the judgment of Justice Robertson. "I cannot understand," said he, "why an investigation into the conduct of city officials should be stopped by a writ which is the slightest indication that a fault with a contractor is to be discovered. Whatever the scope of the inquiry as ordered by the municipality, the learned Justice in the Chancery Court misunderstood the position of affairs altogether."

The coal and wood supplied delivered at the respective institutions in quality and manner satisfactory to the Government and it is agreed that until the 30th Sept. next except for the Normal School, the Government will pay the Education Department, one-half the amount of the bill for coal and wood delivered and the full amount for fuel delivered until after the 15th of October. The Government will also pay the full amount for fuel delivered at the Normal School Hall until it is weighed at the Public Buildings or other recognized scales, and the full amount for fuel delivered at the Normal Institution. The wood must be of good quality and must be delivered in accordance with the usual official maps and the residue of the wood must be sold at public auction. The forms of tender and other information can be obtained from the Department of the Interior and will be received for the supply of the fuel tenders on or before the 15th Sept. and submitted separately for Toronto and Ottawa. The signatures of two different parties will be required on each tender and the contract will be made on each of the contracts.
