

Mr. L. W. Elliott, secty of the Anwrites the MONITOR that he desires be advised of those who are naking an effort to raise clover seed s he may engage the huller and place it where it will be the most benefit to Mr. Elliott has also received the following letter from the Department of Agriculture, Truro: DEAR MR. ELLIOTT—From reports I have received from our District Officer in Western Ontario I am led to believe that there will be very little red clover seed produced in Ontario this season; and while we will probably have plenty of red lover seed on the market at perhaps a slightly lower price than last season it will be chiefly imported which as you probably rom experience is not of much value the Nova Scotia farmer Thereore I would ask you to encourage in every way you can the farmers in district to save as much as ossible this year.

From samples I received last spring from growers in your district I infer that the principal fault with is the habit of cutting the before it is properly ripened. n your district if the first crop is rvested in the next ten days, there should be no trouble in having uccess with the second crop.
