So also, they are made verbs, by the use of verbal prefixes and suffixes; as,

ā wi'yuh het, it will become good, or it will make good; (i. e., some object.)

ā wa'et gānt, or āga'et gānt, it will become bad, or, it will make bad, corrupt, spoil; (i. e., some object.) But this matter will be more fully explained under the head of Verbal Prefixes and Suffixes.
