Household Hints.

CHEESE SANDWICHES.—Grated cheese, yolks of hard-boiled eggs, melted butter, pepper and salt; mix and spread like meat sandwiches.

FRECKLED OR TANNED SKIN.—Chloride of ammonia, one drachm; distilled water, one pint; lavender water, two drachms. It is to be dabbed on the freckled skin two three times a day.

FLY POISON.—The white of an egg stirred stiff with sugar and black pepper acts as a fly poison, and beeswax mixed into thickness with Burgundy pitch and then spread upon paper detains the flies so unlucky as to light upon it.

DROPS.—Cut up some cold lamb into pieces about two inches square and one inch deep. Dip these into well-beaten eggs, then into bread crumbs which have been seasoned with shredded parsley, sweet herbs, pepper and salt. Fry in boiling lard till crisp and brown.

PRUNE PUDDING.—Stew the prunes until soft, remove the stones, add sugar and whites of three eggs, beaten to a stiff froth. Make a puff paste for the bottom of pudding dish. After beating the eggs and prunes together till they are thoroughly mixed, spread them on the crust. Bake for half an hour.

BAKED MACARONI.—Cook the macaroni tender in broth and take twice its weight in minced chicken or meat, adding two well-beaten eggs, three ounces of butter, cayenne pepper and salt to taste. Mix the ingredients well, put them into a deep dish and bake until a light brown crust shall be formed upon the top.

COCONUT PUDDING.—To a quart of milk add four well-beaten eggs, sugar to make it as sweet as for ordinary custard, a small pinch of salt, a tablespoonful of butter, half a teaspoonful of extract of vanilla, and half a freshly-grated coconut. Bake to a delicate brown, or until the custard just stiffens. To be eaten hot or cold, as preferred.

BERMUDA WITCHES.—Cut rice, pound or sponge cake the sixth of an inch thick. Take off the crust and spread one-half with any kind of jelly. On this stew grated coconut. Press it over the remainder of the cake, and trim into good form. Pile them in a pretty fashion on a white serviette; garnish with sprigs of myrtle.

COLD MEAT LOAF.—Chop any kind of good, cold meat, season with salt and pepper and place in a mould. Take the bones and bits of meat and boil them with an onion or two cut fine. When boiled enough, strain, and add one spoonful of gelatine dissolved. Pour this over the meat and set away to cool and harden.

TEA RUSKS.—Rusks raised without yeast are so much more quickly made than with it that they are preferable for warm weather. Three teacupful flour, one of milk, two tablespoonful butter, two eggs, three-fourths teacupful sugar, three teaspoonful baking powder, and a pinch of salt. Rub the butter and sugar together, add the well-beaten eggs, and lastly the flour. Bake like tea biscuits in a quick oven.
