time as occasion may require, so long as he continues to be a Member of the said House, without being re-elected; and every such fresh declaration may be made before the same officers, and shall be subject to and governed by the same provisions of this Act as any first declaration made thereunder; and all and every the provisions of this Act relating to declarations by Candidates, shall apply to declarations by Members and to the Members making the same and to all persons in respect thereof, so far as applicable, in the same manner as if the same were here repeated in reference thereto, and to such Members and other persons respectively.
