and pervade the whole school with right principles. It is not necessary that Rugby should have 300 or 250 or 200, but it is necessary that we should have a company of good Christian young men, loving what is true, and what is honest, and what is upright." My friends, the world wants to be pervaded; and it is through you, the Christian men and the Christian women, that this is to be done. through the Church. The world does not read our Bible; it reads you, and the worldling says: "If that's the Bible that I read in and through you-short, dishonest, getting the better of me, cheating, thinking of nothing but piling up your money as you can-I don't want your Bible, we have got a better Bible here; we do a little, any way, to help one another." Thus the pervading thought of the world would be, the thinking right, the speaking right and the doing right. Might would lose its place and right would be enthroned. Whither would this lead us! Even to the very millennium itself. But. was not that just what God intended? This was the guide-book to lead men to the ideal Man, the second Adam, and to Him that gives the force and life to live up to that ideal; to lead up to the day when Satan shall be disenthroned and the kingdoms of this world shall become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ. God lead us to rise to our responsibility. May He give us a living faith in Him and His blessed Word. May He give this convention divine power whereby His Word will be exalted, its teachings lived, and make every page a leaf for the healing of the nations. (Loud and longcontinued applause.)
