

to submit that certain information is confidential in its nature and if the Committee agree, this information should be left out of the printed report, marked "confidential" and filed with the records of the Inquiry.

6. *Manner of Placing Material before the Committee.*—That voluminous data furnished by the companies and other witnesses be not printed unless specifically requested by the Committee but that it be filed as Exhibit and made part of the Inquiry. Further, that the oral examination be directed to the important element in each document for the purpose of clarification and that it be recognized that the detailed information is filed among the records of the Committee and would have to be referred to for this purpose.

Resolved,—That the Clerk be instructed to print in galley form the submission to be presented by Mr. Walter Macdonald, C.A., auditor for the Committee, at the next meeting of the Committee.
