CROWN LAND DEPARTMENT,

Toronto, March 31, 1851.

Sir,

Having brought under the notice of the Government the prohibition (embraced in the 2nd paragraph, respecting the Sales of Clergy Reserves, of the general instructions of November 1845,) from selling such lands at less than 8s. per acre, I have to inform you that the Department is authorized to dispose of lots at less than that price, provided it be clearly proved that they are of an inferior quality; which you will be careful to ascertain, demanding for them an appropriate price.

This is equally applicable to lots not included in the inspection of 1844, for which applicants have to furnish Certificates of a Licensed Surveyor, and upon which your report is required by the 13th paragraph of the same instructions.
